

## SHERIDAN COMMUNITY HOSPITAL ANNOUNCES CEO SEPARATION

SHERIDAN, Mich. (August 2019) – The Sheridan Community Hospital Board announced the separation of its Chief Executive Officer, Randall Flechsig, effective immediately.

In order to ensure continuity going forward, the Board has appointed Bobbi McColley, Compliance Officer and Director of Clinical Support, to be Sheridan Community Hospital's interim Chief Executive Officer. As interim Chief Executive Officer, Ms. McColley will work with the hospital's management team to facilitate an orderly leadership transition, while overseeing the organization's ongoing transformation.

"The Board had a vision, even before Randy arrived, to provide employment and local, available, quality healthcare services in Montcalm County and the surrounding communities," stated Marvin Jay Tans, Sheridan Community Hospital's Board President. "Sheridan Community Hospital is the sixth largest employer in Montcalm County, and as before, we will continue to make a positive economic impact on the community."
