Today the Michigan Attorney General’s Office charged one of our members – Officer Jason Diaz of the City of Lowell – with multiple allegations that – in fact – arose out of the lawful performance of his duties.

Officer Diaz will be represented by criminal defense Attorney Marc Curtis. Attorney Marc Curtis is of our Statewide criminal defense attorneys that are provided by the Fraternal Order of Police Labor Council to all its members.

Officer Diaz will be vigorously defended by Attorney Curtis and the Fraternal Order of Police Labor Council – in order to show the public that Officer Diaz acted in the lawful self-defense of himself and those who he swore to protect. He acted in accordance with the law – as well as – his Department policies – and his training. Officer Diaz was in fact cleared by his department after an internal investigation was concluded and resumed active patrol duties several weeks ago.

Officer Jason Diaz, like thousands of other officers go to work every day in Michigan to protect the public and stop crime. The work they do is hard and requires them to make split second decisions, whereas others get the luxury to second guess them for months and even years.

In this time of intense law enforcement scrutiny, the Fraternal Order of Police Labor Council will ensure that the true facts of this incident become fully known and understood by both the public and the Courts.
